Explanation of items listed in Cost Sheet:

Oklahoma Resident Tuition & Fees = \$140.00 per credit hour for in-class and \$175 for on-line courses – This includes tuition and administrative fees. This would result in an "in-state student" paying \$10,535 in tuition for the entire program. This is based on campus course tuition for the 69 credit hours. This does not include any additional courses that may be needed to prepare the student to take program prerequisite classes if they require pre-college level course work required based on student placement testing.

Non-Resident Tuition & Fees =\$301.00 per credit hour and estimate of \$500 in fees – This would result in an "outof-state student" paying \$23,000 for tuition. This does not include additional program specific costs or additional courses that may be needed to prepare the student to take program prerequisite classes.
